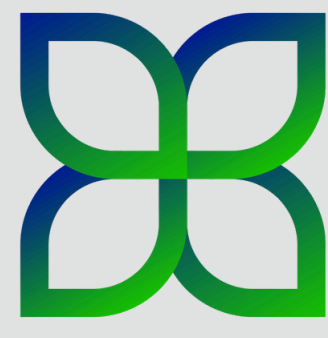




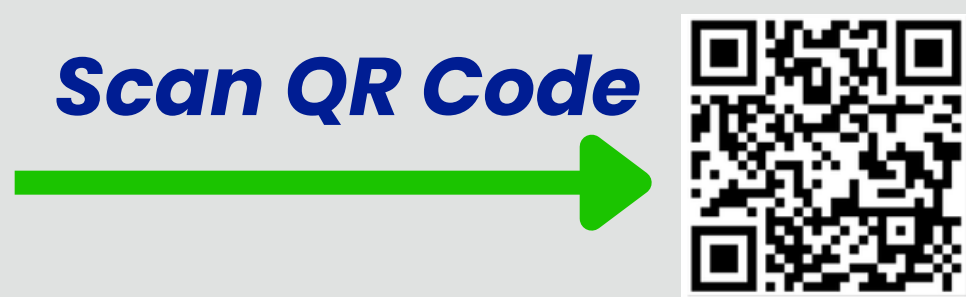
01 Hope

We continue our support of six primary and two secondary Christian schools, recognized seven Valasek Leadership Award recipients, and saw many students complete their education.

Summer mission trips included medical and mental health clinics, community outreaches, and conferences for men, women and youth while engaging in evangelism and discipleship.

The installation of wells ensured clean water access, monthly pastor training sessions were held, 1500 Bibles were distributed, and weekly slum feedings were funded.

For the past 15 years, Engage Hope has been dedicated to providing support for the needs of our in-country ministry partners without any additional fees. To further our commitment to transparency and sustainability, we will be implementing a 4% administration fee on designated restricted donations. This fee will apply to funds dated after March 15, 2025, and will help support the execution of The Engage Hope Vision.
